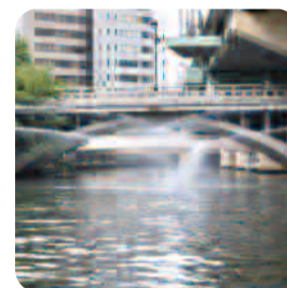

River Station Hachikenya
A waterfront information facility with a restaurant, and a rental and community space called Station 8.



Kitahama Terrace
A waterside facility with boat rides, water activities including SUP, rental spaces, restaurants and cafes.



β HOMMACHI BASHI
A waterside facility with boat rides, water activities including SUP, rental spaces, restaurants and cafes.



Hotarumachi
A lively waterside facility with restaurants and cafes. Home to Asahi Broadcasting, ABC Hall, Dojima Crosswalk, and Dojima River Forum.



NAKANOSHIMA BANKS
A riverside facility directly connected to Kaihan Nakanoshima Station, with restaurants, flagship stores for leather and apparel brands, bars, cafes, and a cruise service.



Nakanoshima Gate Terminal
Located at the gateway to the Bay Area, this new building base is a place to transfer between ferries and ocean-going vessels. It also introduces the area's history as the location where Osaka's port was opened.



TOMBORI RIVERWALK
This promenade opened in December 2004 along the Dotombori River. Various events are held here, and there are a number of restaurants along the river.



Canal Terrace Horie
A fashionable spot in Osaka with tasteful restaurants and five unique stores that are open from lunchtime until late at night.



TUGBOAT_TAISHO
A complex with 16 highly-rated restaurants where you can enjoy the waterside view while listening to music from the live space and DJ space.

Osaka, City of Water

The city of Osaka was born from the sea

Around 6,000 to 7,000 years ago, the Osaka urban area was largely part of the sea, with the Uemachi Plateau jutting out into Kawachi Bay. As the sea level gradually fell, sediment that flowed in from the Yodo River was deposited and turned into land, forming the Kawachi Plain around the 5th century. Facing the Seto Inland Sea, Osaka was a gateway to the world and an international trading port, where envoys to the Sui and Tang Dynasties arrived and departed. It was also the eastern terminus of the Silk Road.

Early modern times: The prosperity of the 808 Bridges of Naniwa

In the late 16th century, towards the end of the Sengoku period, Toyotomi Hideyoshi built Osaka Castle and made effective use of waterways in the urban development of Osaka, including the digging of the canal and

installation of sewers. Even after Hideyoshi's death, these projects continued. The canal dug by the townspeople stretched out like a capillary, and by the mid-17th century, Osaka was at its peak as a water city. Nakanoshima was lined with warehouses belonging to the domains, and rice and other products from all over the country were brought there. Osaka came to be known as the "nation's kitchen." With the development of the Kitamaebune route around the Seto Inland Sea, Sea of Japan, and Pacific Ocean, Osaka became Japan's largest distribution hub. The Yodo River was a major artery connecting Osaka and Kyoto, with the boat called "Sanjikkoku-Bune" frequently travelling from Temmabashi / Hachikenyahama to Fushimi in Kyoto. At its peak, there are records of 320 trips and 9,000 people coming and going each day. The ukiyo-e set of woodblock prints called Naniwa Hyakkei (One Hundred Views of Naniwa) depict a variety of waterside landscapes. The area was called "the 808 Bridges of Naniwa" due to the large number of bridges.

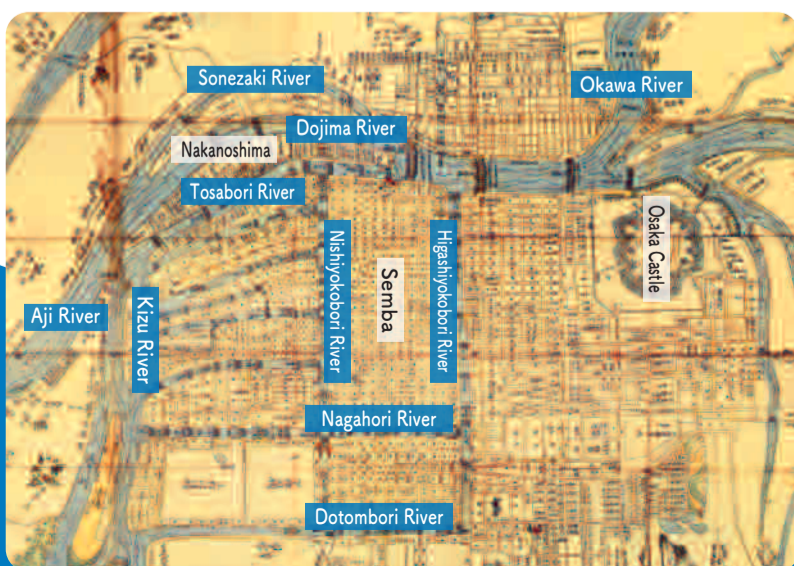
The waterside landscape became a part of people's everyday lives. People enjoyed the changing seasons along the waterside, with the Tenjin Festival, cherry blossom viewing, the cool breeze in summer, and moon viewing.

Loss of waterfront

The end of the 19th century saw the development of industries that used water transportation, but the excessive pumping of groundwater for industrial use led to land subsidence and a growing fear that the river would cause flooding. As railways were built and roads developed, water transport was gradually surpassed by land transport. Canal and River began to lose its purpose, and became a dumping ground for debris from air raids during World War II. Due to the stench caused by wastewater from the period of high economic growth, it was treated as a nuisance and gradually filled in, as the people turned their backs on the river.

Creating new value near the waterfront

With the end of the period of high economic growth, people began to reflect on the deterioration of the waterfront environment in Osaka. In 1980, the Osaka Urban Environment Council proposed the "Water City 30-year revitalization strategy" that included environmental standards, the operation of water buses, and the creation of a promenade along the Dotombori River. In 2001, Osaka Prefecture, Osaka City, and the business community jointly proposed the "Water City Osaka Revitalization Plan," which was adopted as a national urban revitalization project. The aim was to revitalize Osaka as a whole by regenerating the Nakanoshima, Higashiyokobori River, Dotombori River, and Kizu River as a "Water Corridor." With the relaxation of rules regarding the use of river spaces in 2011, commercial activities such as waterside cafes were allowed, and a number of lively waterside spaces were created. "Mitsukushi" is a navigational marker erected at the river mouth to ensure safe navigation for ships. Because Osaka's prosperity has long benefited from water transportation, it was chosen as the city's emblem in 1888. Modern Osaka has inherited the DNA of a water city, and continues to evolve as an attractive city that people want to live in and visit.

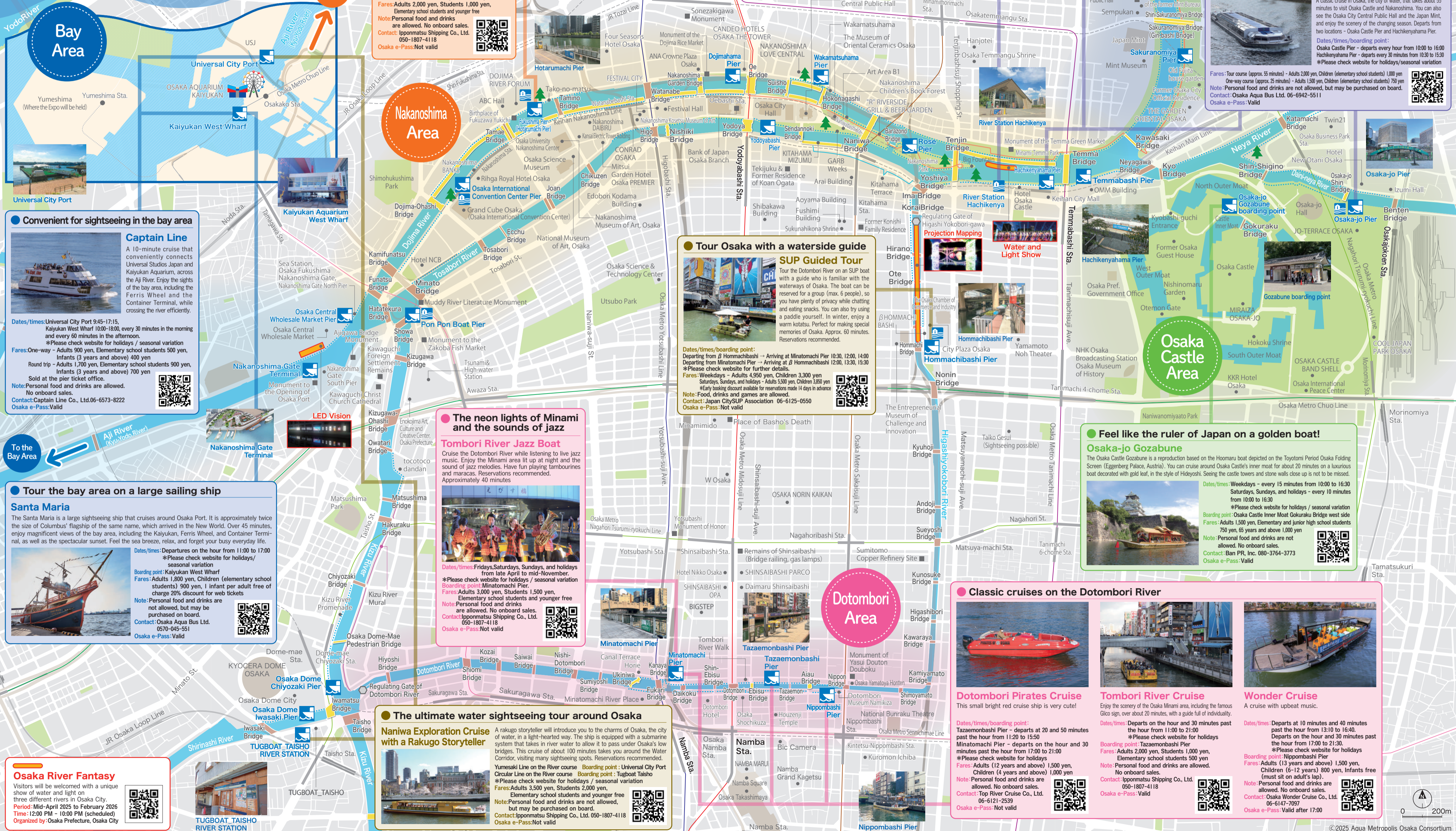
